If you are travelling from M6 Junction 10a:

Exit M6 onto the M54, heading for Telford. Continue past Telford to the end of the M54, where it becomes the A5. Continue towards Shrewsbury and at the roundabout with the A49 turn left, still on the A5. Turn right at the next roundabout and the College (signposted) is after the crematorium on your right.

If you are travelling from M5 Junction 3 and Bridgnorth:

Exit M5 at junction 3 on the A458 towards Bridgnorth. Follow A458 out of Bridgnorth, towards Shrewsbury. On approaching Shrewsbury follow the A458 goes over the A5 and at the roundabout turn right onto the B4380. At the next roundabout turn left onto London Road. The College (signposted) is after the crematorium on your right.

Parking: Free parking is available for delegates attending the course. The car park is located directly opposite the Enterprise Centre. The below image shows this.
