#### **DIRECTIONS AND PARKING**

#### Driving

#### From the East

• Leave the M4 Motorway at Junction 29 and take A48(M) (Eastern Avenue). Stay on this road for approximately 5.5 miles.

• The Hospital will become visible on the right. Leave Eastern Avenue along an exit slip road leading up to the Hospital Site and Multi-Storey Car Park.

#### From the West/North

• Leave the M4 at Junction 32 travelling along the A470 (Northern Avenue/ Manor Way) for a distance of approximately 2 miles.

• Proceed to the Gabalfa Interchange following the signs to Newport and M4 East, exiting via the slip-road leading directly onto the Hospital Site.

#### **Parking**

The current NHS rules for parking at the University Hospital of Wales allow visitors to park within the hospital car parks for a maximum of 8 hours only. This is something that is beyond our remit, and the rules are laid down by the hospital. We would, therefore, suggest that you make alternative arrangements to reach the hospital, such as via taxi or public transport (see details below). You may consider parking your car for 8 hours in the hospital and moving it out during the afternoon break. Parking is free, but you will need to register your car details at one of terminals in order to park for more than 4 hours.

#### **Public Transport**

• If you are travelling by bus or train into Cardiff, you will arrive at Cardiff Central Station. The distance between the station and the Hospital is approximately 3 miles.

• There is a regular Cardiff Bus service from the City Centre (not Cardiff Central) to the Hospital - numbers 38 and 39. The journey should last approximately 25-30 minutes.

Alternatively, a journey from the station by taxi should take approximately 10 minutes.
