# 3<sup>rd</sup> Dublin Infant Hip Ultrasound Course:

For the Diagnosis and Management of Developmental Dysplasia of the Infant Hip Using the Graf Method

Previously known as the Graf Course, this course followed the same format as the hugely popular course run by Dr Sally Scott in the UK for the last 28 years. The course aimed to provide the participants with a thorough understanding of the role of ultrasound in the diagnosis and management of Developmental Dysplasia of the Hip (previously known as Congenital Dislocation of the Hip), according to the Graf method.

The course covered the theoretical knowledge and practical skills necessary to perform and interpret infant hip ultrasound examinations, and the management based on ultrasound findings. Aspects such as the choice of equipment and setting up an ultrasound service were also covered.





Anatomy of the Infant Hip














































## **Individual Comments**
