











# Keele National Suturing Course and Competition

This one-day course was designed to provide participants with a structured programme to gain proficiency in basic suturing skills. Utilising animal tissue and with a high delegate-to-tutor ratio, participants had ample opportunity and guidance to improve their technique.

The course concluded with a competition, allowing delegates to test the skills that they learnt and refined during the day. Those who scored the highest were awarded a prize.






