National Undergraduate Conference for Anaesthetics and Critical Care Conference 2019

The National Undergraduate Conference for Anaesthetics and Critical Care 2019 was aimed at undergraduate medical students with an interest in anaesthetics and critical care medicine.

Glasgow Anaesthetics Society aimed to provide students with the opportunity to gain an insight into the fields of anaesthetics and critical care medicine by inviting specialists to speak on a range of topics. Delegates were advised on how to build a successful CV when specialising in anaesthetics, paediatric anaesthesia, neuroanaesthesia and emergency transfer medicine.

Moreover, clinical skills stations, led by volunteer clinicians, allowed students to develop their interests in the fields of anaesthetics and critical care medicine, whilst practicing their skills using specialised equipment.

Glasgow Anaesthetics Society encouraged undergraduate research by providing students with opportunities for poster presentations, awarding prizes to the best overall projects.

As the only undergraduate and critical care conference in Scotland, Glasgow Anaesthetics Society has previously been joined by students from Oxford, Manchester, Nottingham and Leicester, with hopes to build further bridges with students from across the UK.







How would you rate the general academic standard of the speakers?





Pre-Hospital Transfer Medicine





Obstetric Anaesthesia











Clinical Skills Workshops Option 1: Group A - Basic Airways, Ultrasound and Central Lines, Spinals and Epidurals





Clinical Skills Workshops Option 2: Group B - Difficult Airways, Ultrasound and Central Lines, Spinals and Epidurals





How were the facilities and venue?










