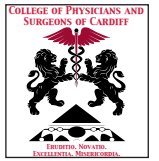

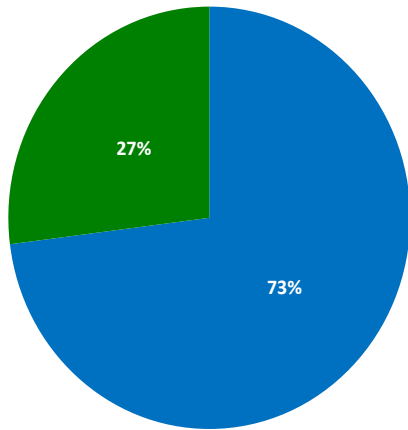

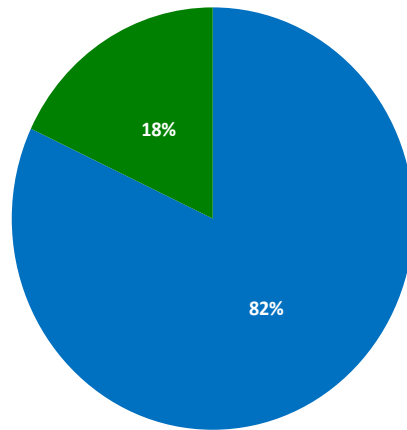

How was the content of the conference?



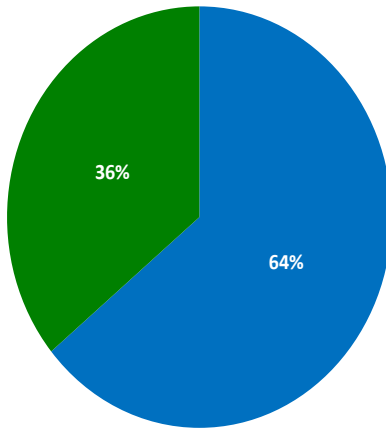

How would you rate the general academic standard of the tutors?



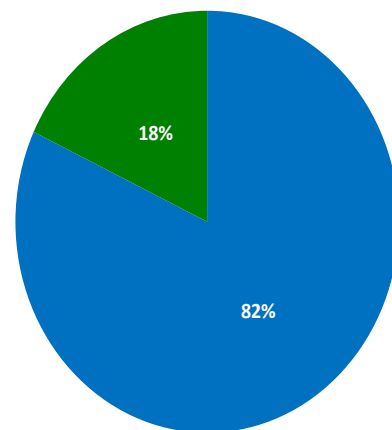

Dr Heather Currie - Menopause



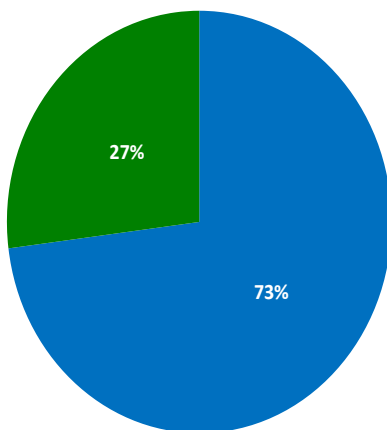

Dr Graham Tydeman - Key learning areas in obstetrics



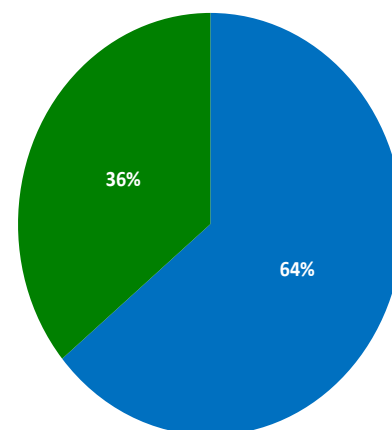

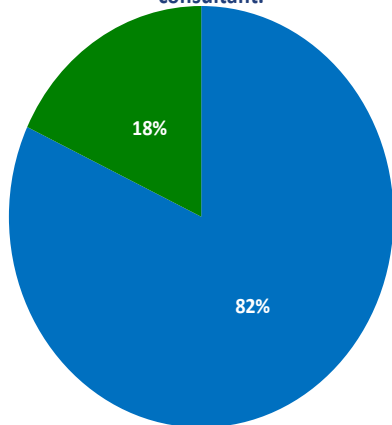
Dr Marcus McMillan - Invasive placentas

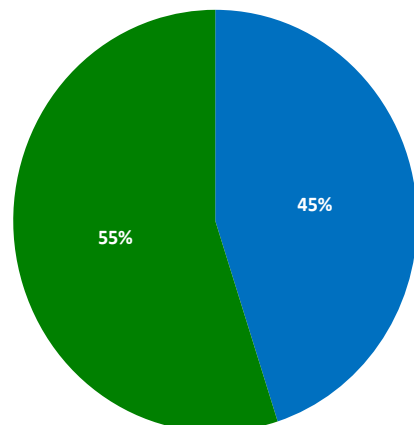

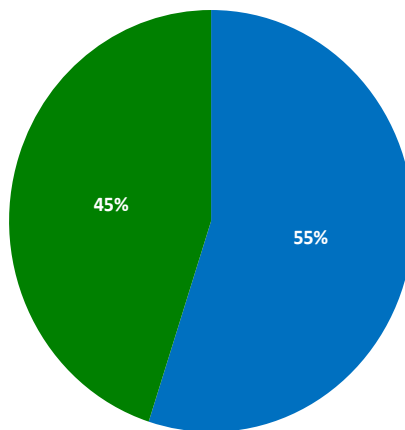
