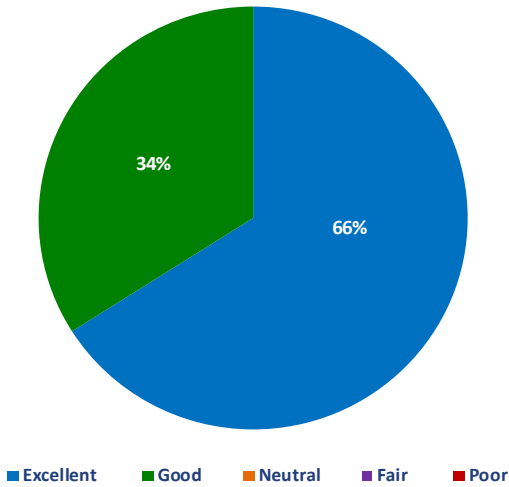

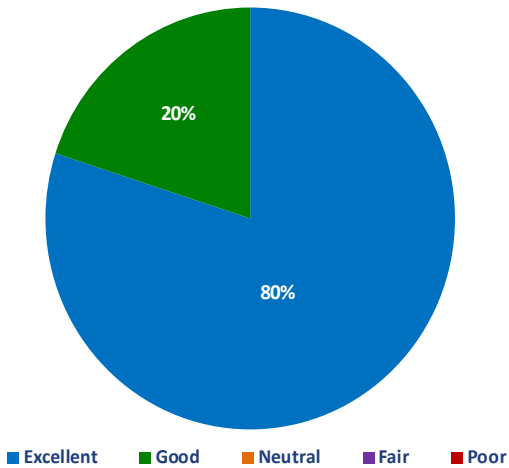

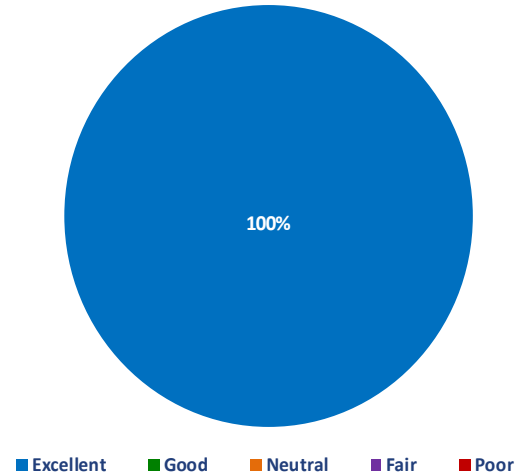
How would you rate the general academic standard of the tutors?



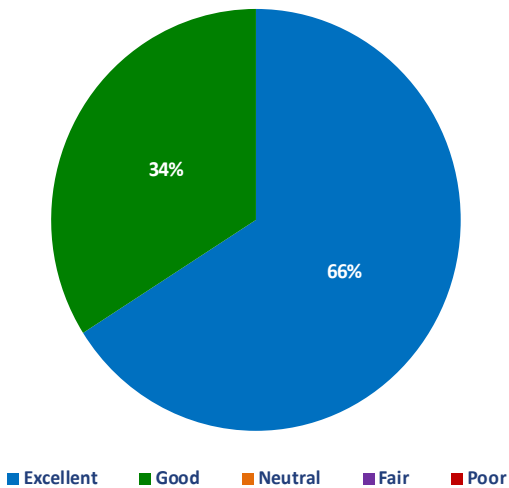

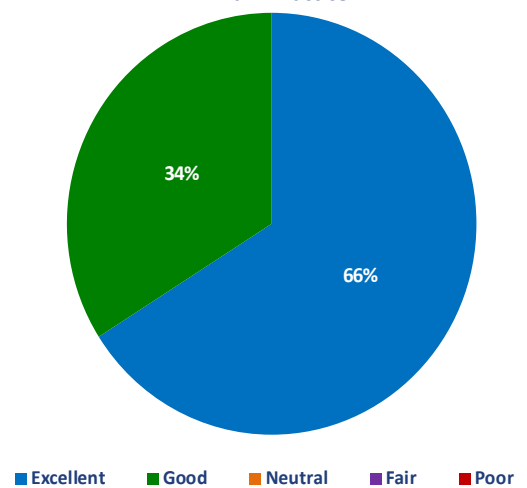

Waiting Times in Gynaecology since the Pandemic - Dr Sangeetha Palaparthy

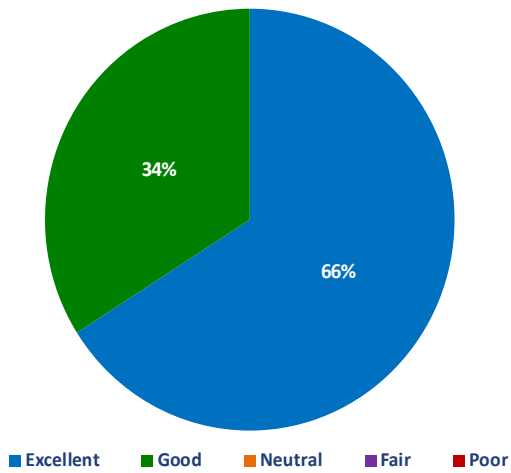


Workshop - Speculum and Bimanual Pelvic Exam Practice

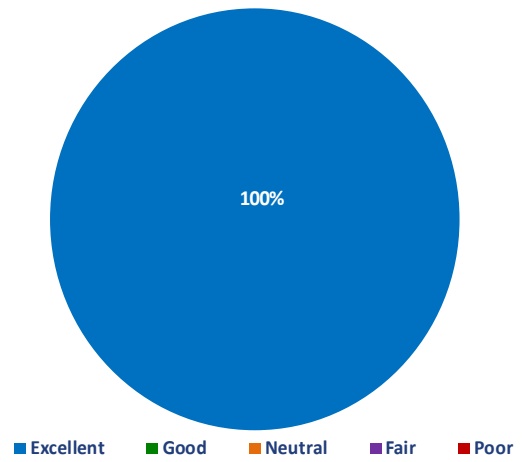

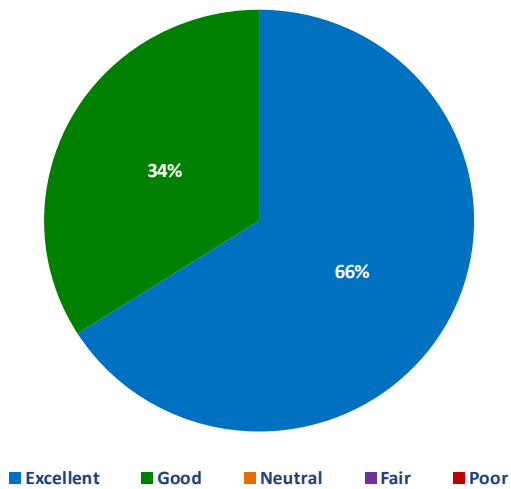

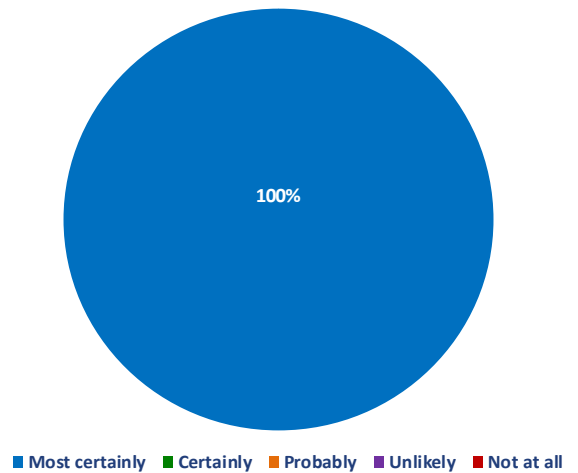
