It is hoped that students would then be able to discuss the skills practised and conceptualised in their applications to Medical School.

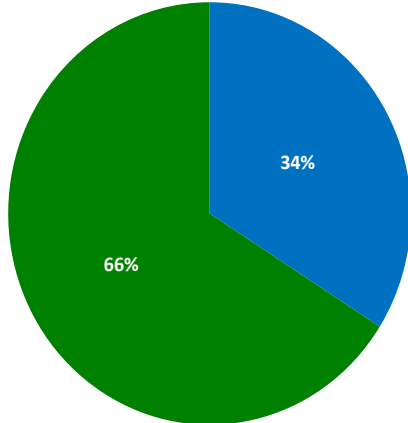

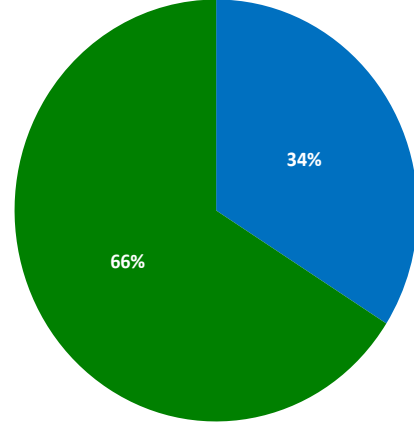

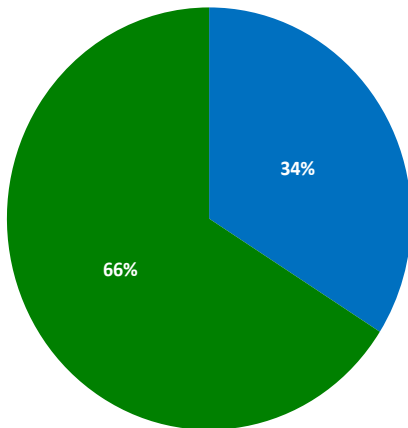

Do you think that you will find the experience useful when you write your personal statement to apply to Medical School and then at the Medical School interviews?



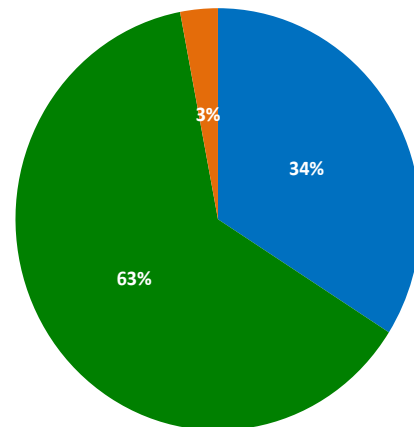

How did you find the suturing session (suturing on animal skin)?



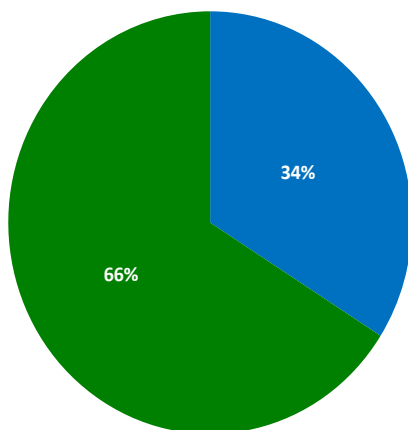

How did you find the session in which you washed-out the contaminated wound and removed the abscess with pus?



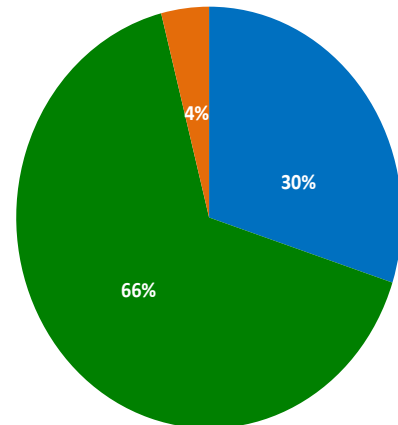

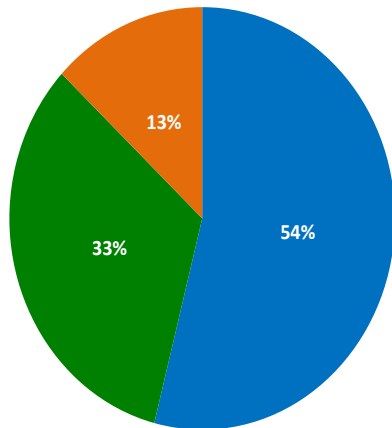
How did you find the surgical diathermy (using electricity to cut and stop bleeding) session?

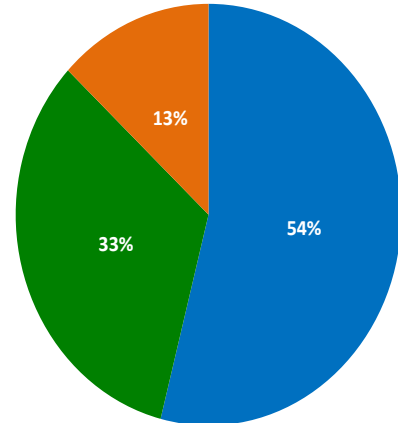
