## Exam-Focused Ophthalmology Revision for Medical School Finals

Ophthalmology is an important speciality in the medical school curriculum and in the final exams. In addition, a number of ophthalmological conditions present to the A&E Department as emergencies. This talk, by Dr Magdalena Nistrata, Senior Registrar at the London Western Eye Hospital, provided a framework for the diagnosis, assessment and management of common ophthalmological conditions and emergencies which will prove very pertinent to medical school final exams.

The session discussed the main points in history taking of common eye complaints to form a differential diagnosis including red eye and vision loss, the main elements of a basic eye examination, the examination of the pupil, the basics of fundoscopy (including assessment of the optic nerve and the retina), and discussion of the salient features of common eye conditions. Dr Neistrata-Ortiz has strong academic credentials and vast experience of teaching at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels.





How would you rate the appropriateness of the topic to your career and/or studies?





How would you rate the expertise of the speaker?





How would you rate the clarity of the information delivered?




