

Attendees could attend whichever session(s) they felt would be beneficial to their revision.







Anatomy and Relevant Pathologies of the Neck





Anatomy and Relevant Pathologies of the Thorax








Anatomy and Nerve Injuries of the Lower Limb



























Wound Healing and Reconstructive Ladder





Sutures and Suture Materials












