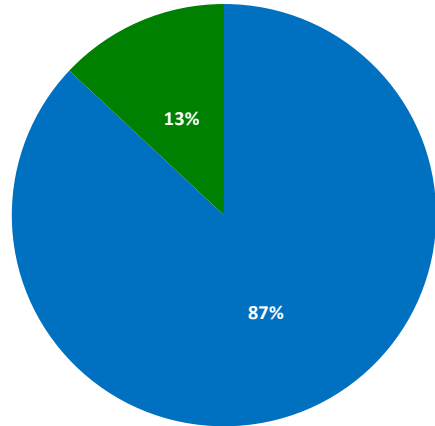

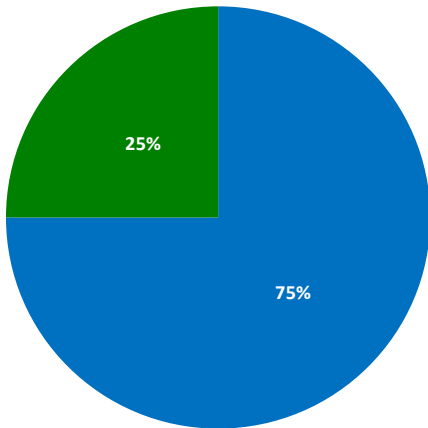

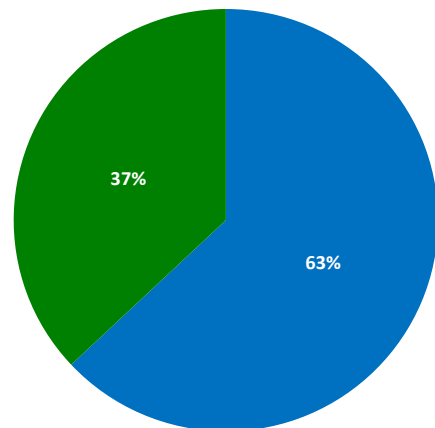

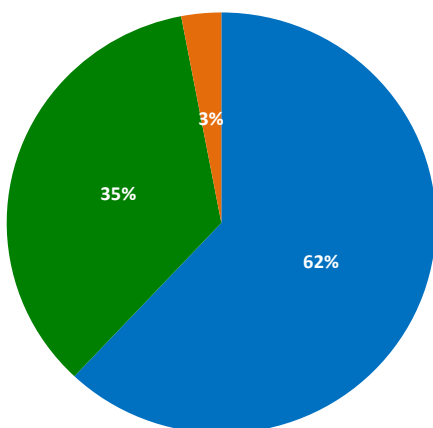

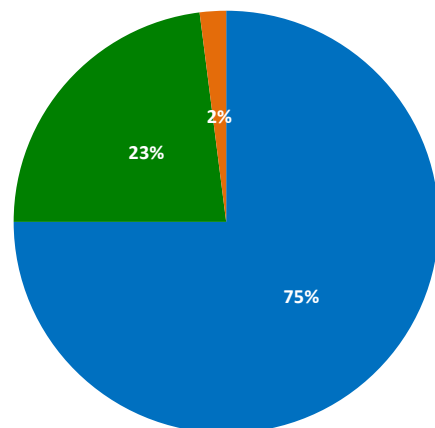

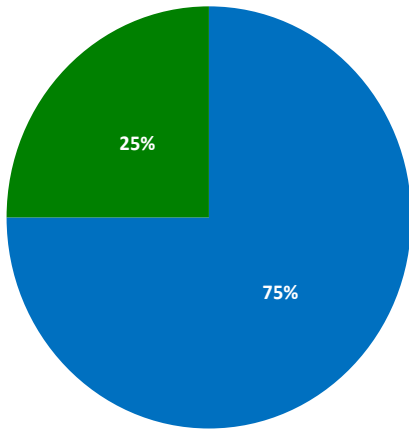
Colorectal Surgery (Benign)

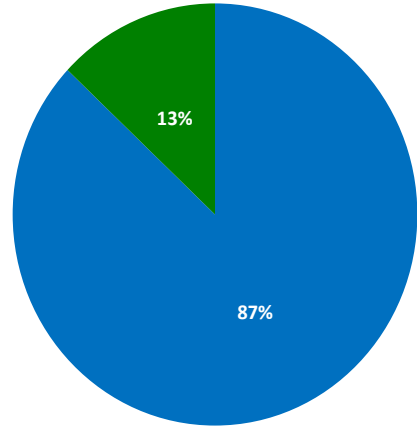

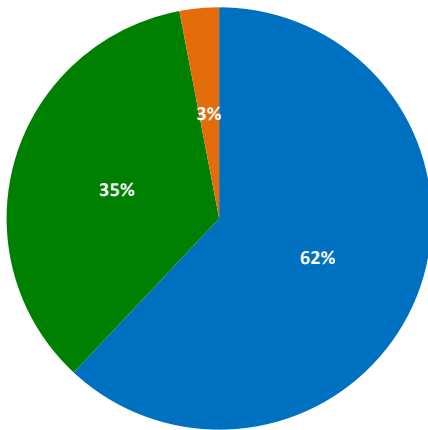

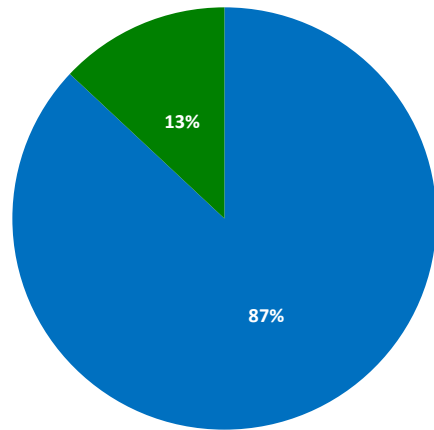

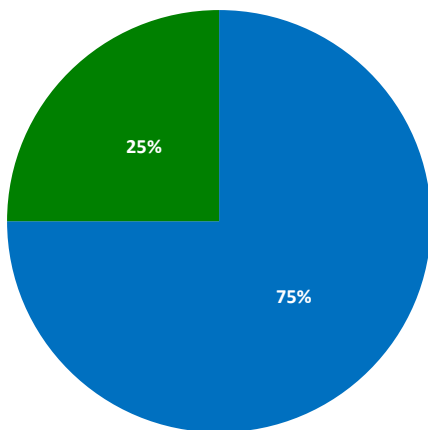

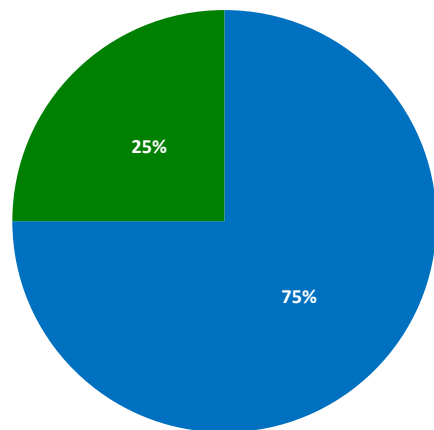

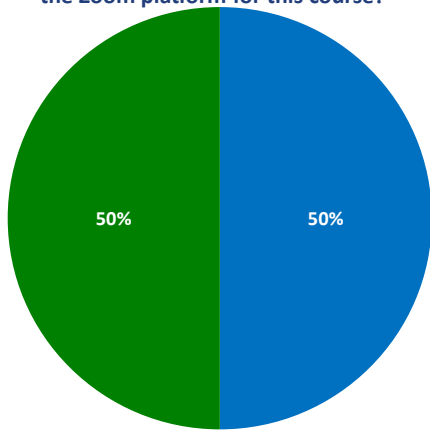

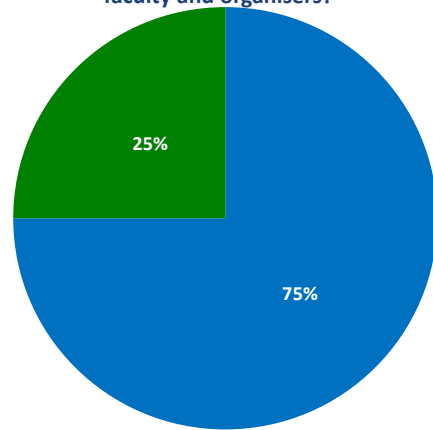

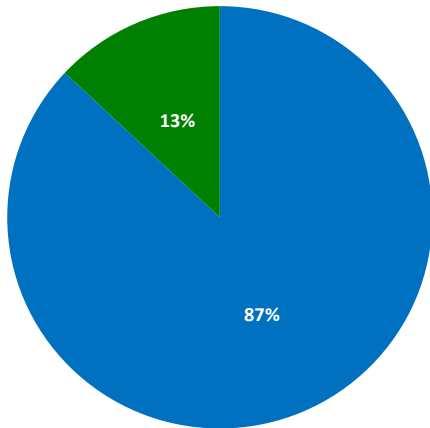
