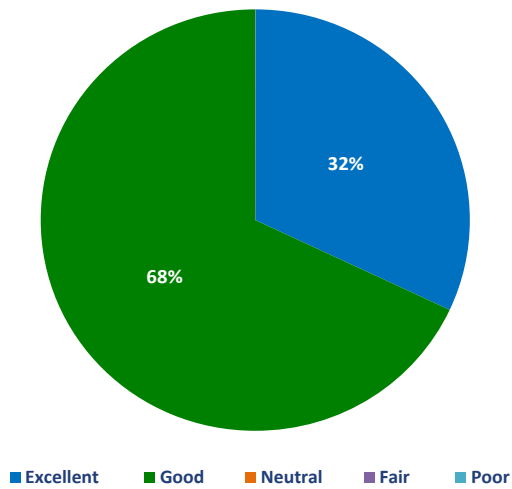

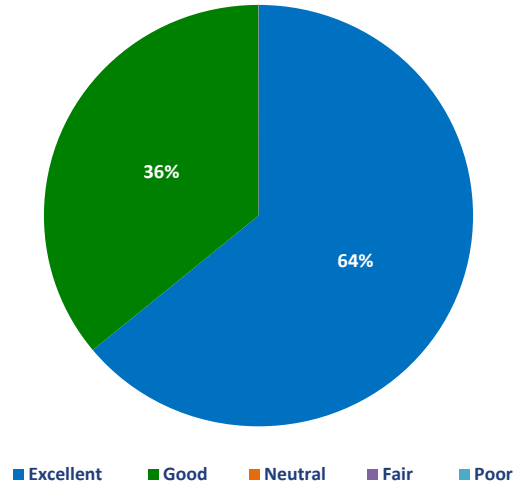

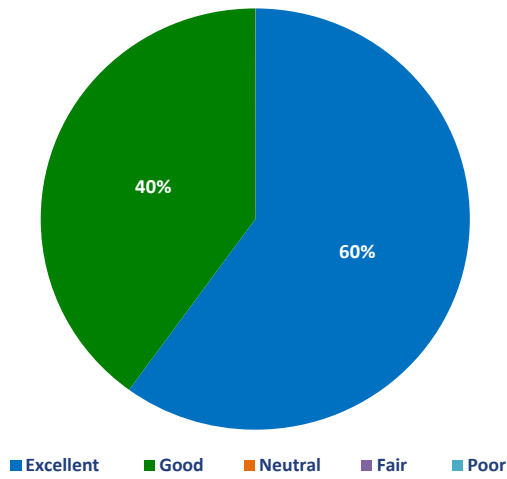
How was the content of the conference?



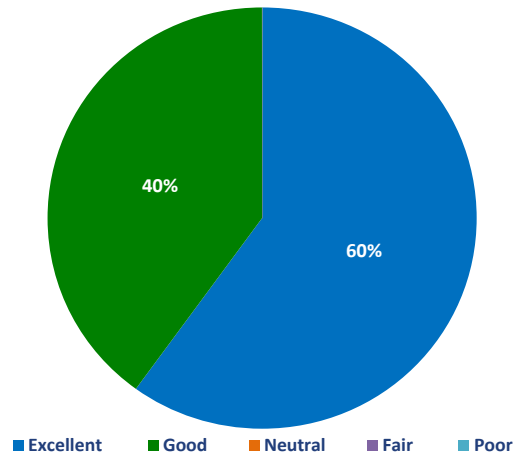
How would you rate the general academic standard of the speakers?



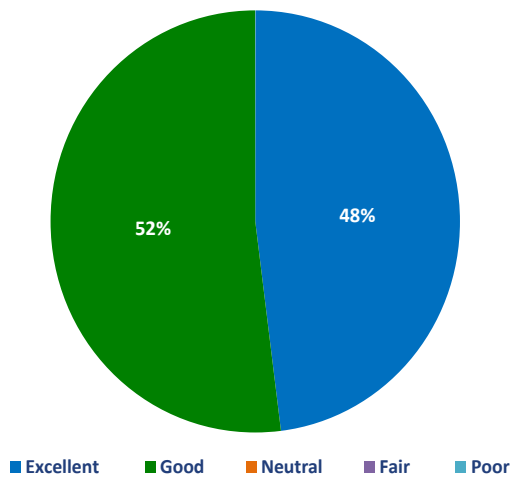

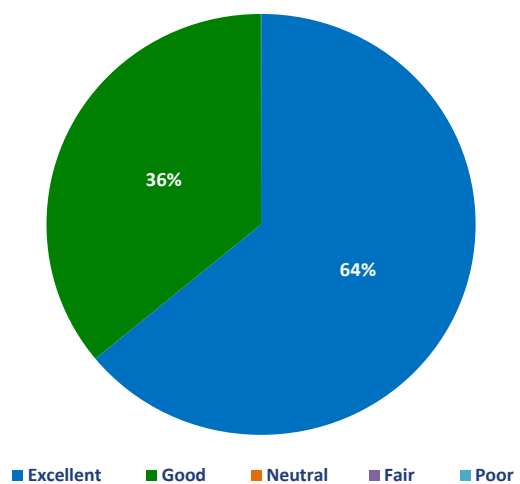

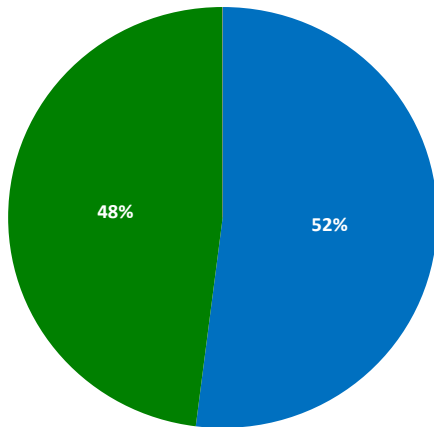

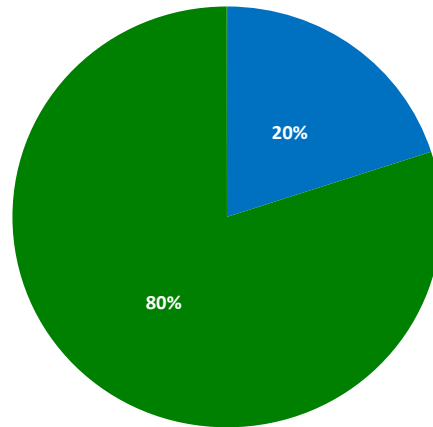

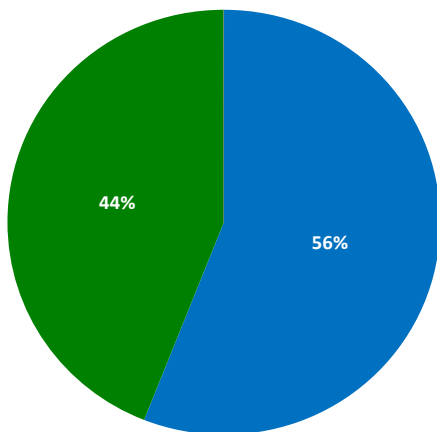

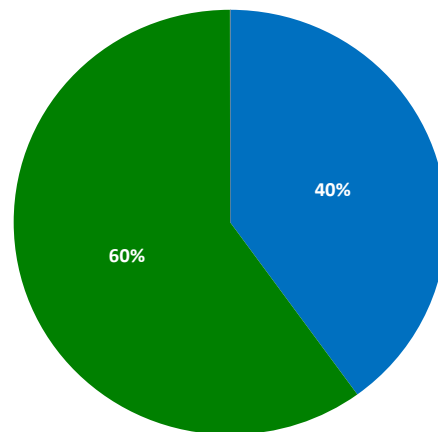

How were the facilities and venue?



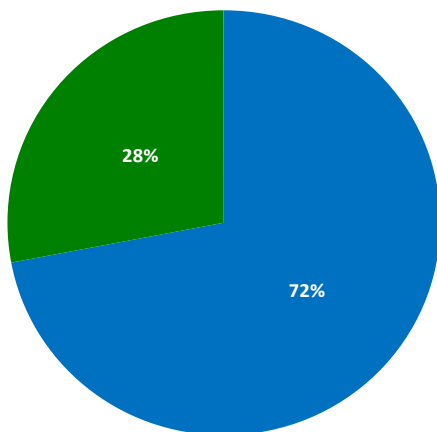

How were the refreshments and lunch?



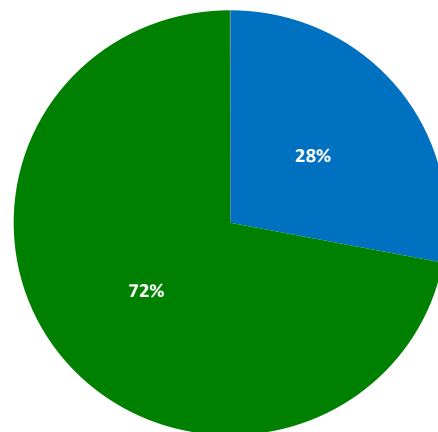

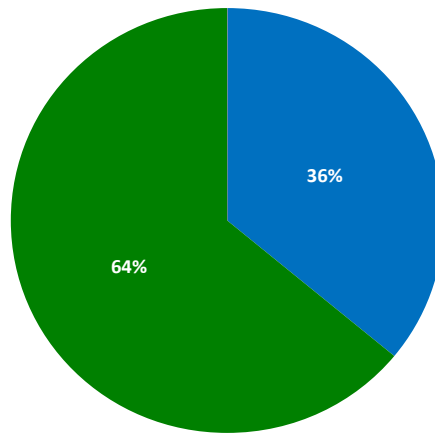
