This one-day event was open to all undergraduate medical students and offered delegates an opportunity to attend three workshops covering a range of surgical skills and specialities. It intended to provide all attendees with the opportunity to deepen their understanding of and enthusiasm for surgery, to gain exposure to a range of surgical specialities, and to build their basic skills from knot-tying to chest drain insertion, portfolio-building to laparoscopic skills. Delegates were encouraged to select learning opportunities from which they could most benefit.
