An Intensive Revision Session for Surgical Finals

This sessions focussed on the common surgical conditions that are tested in the medical school final exam (4th year and 5th/6th year). The sessions covered triangles of the neck, neck lumps, thyroid disorders and lumps, pancreas and gall bladder, IBD, colonic conditions, acute abdomen, and colorectal cancers and their management. The sessions were interactive and in a question-and-answer format highlighting the high yield and most essential topics within each section.

The revision sessions were delivered by Professor S. Enoch, Director and Head of Postgraduate Surgical Education at the Doctors Academy Group of Educational Establishments. He is the convenor of the prestigious Cardiff MRCS Courses and a Surgical Tutor of the Intercollegiate Basic Surgical Skills courses. He teaches medical students, junior doctors and postgraduate surgeons on a regular basis.





How would you rate the appropriateness of the topic to your career and/or studies?





How would you rate the expertise of the speaker?





How would you rate the clarity of the information delivered?




