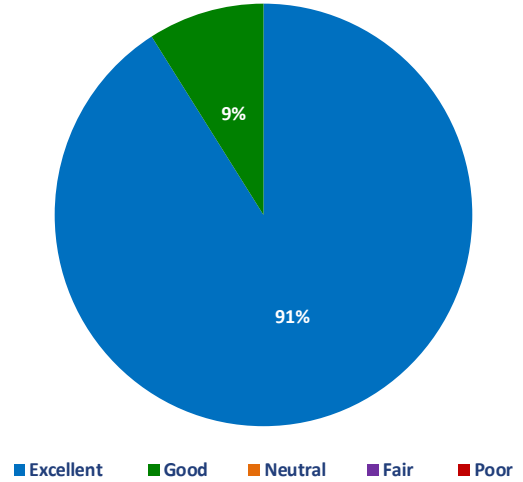

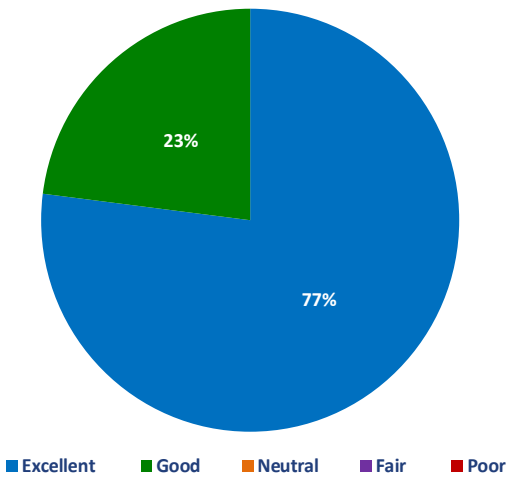
How would you rate the appropriateness of the topic to your career and/or studies?



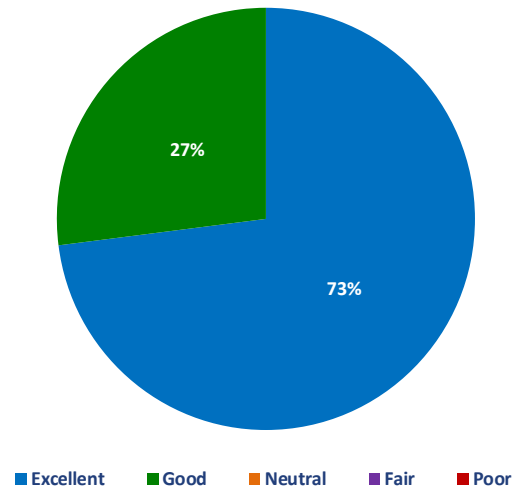
How would you rate the expertise of the speaker?



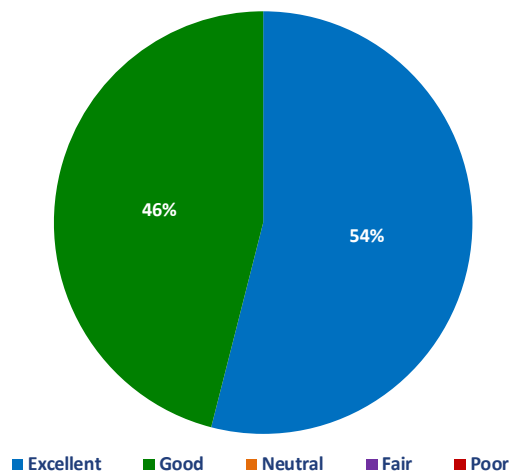
