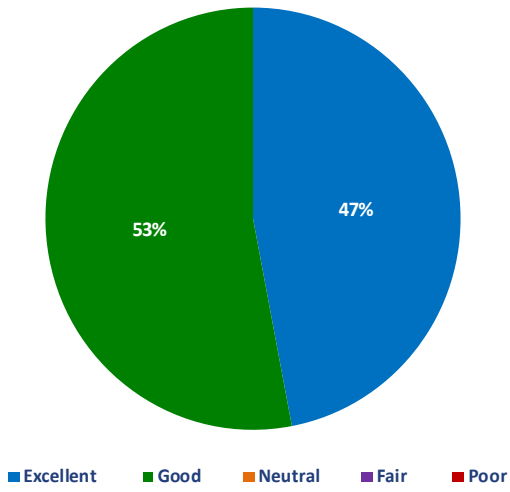

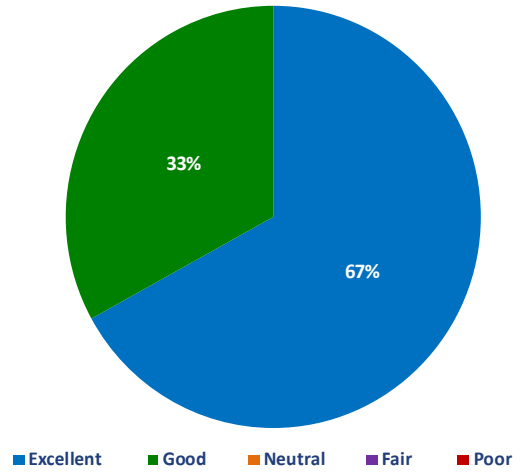

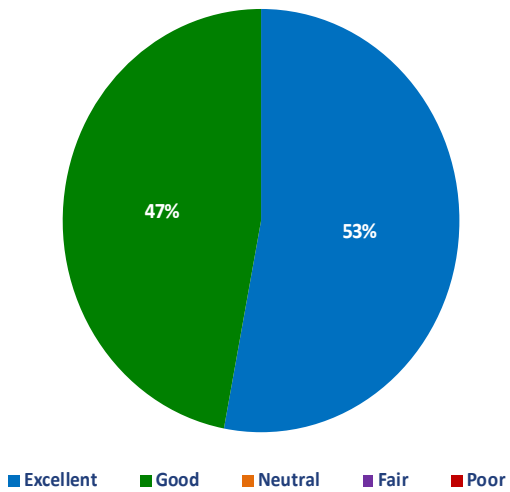
How was the content of the conference?



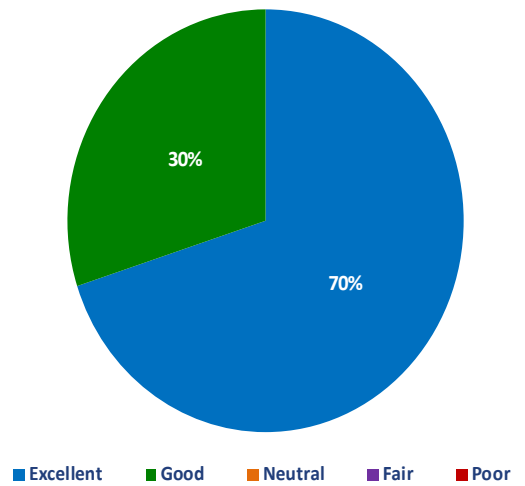
How would you rate the general academic standard of the tutors?



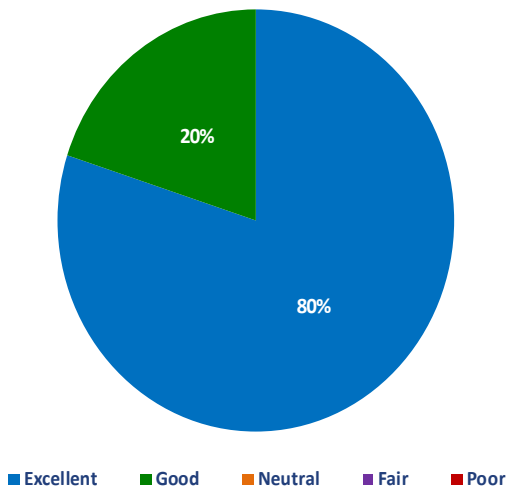

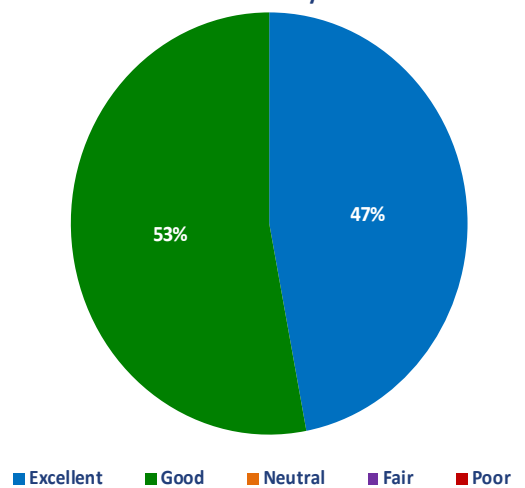
Dr Mimmagh - "Transgender health"

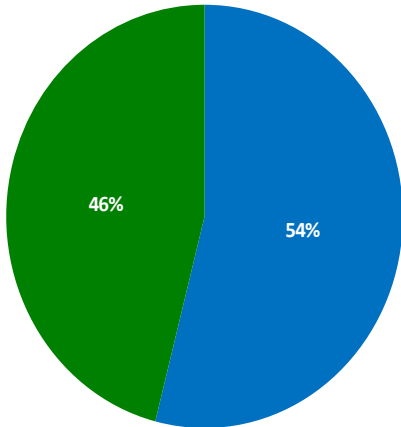


Oral Dr McKiernan - "Physical ill health and disability"



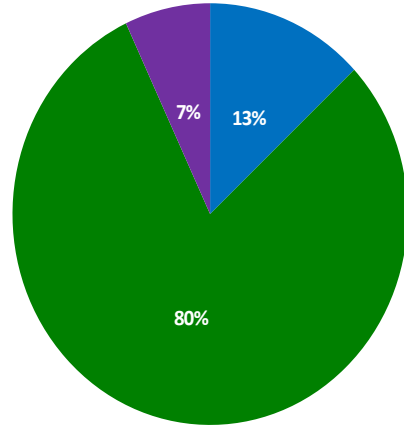

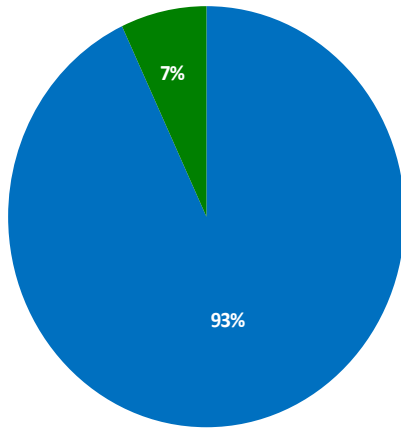

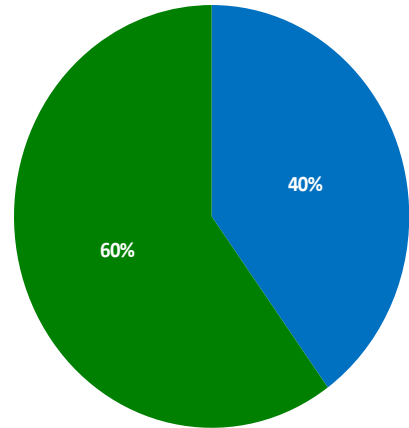

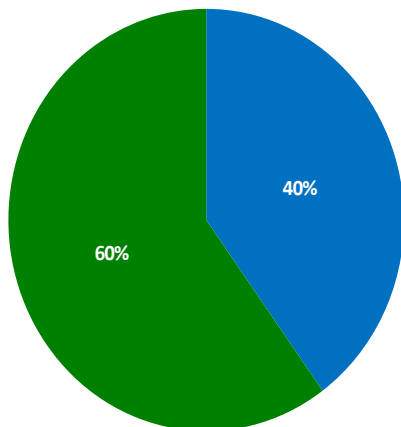

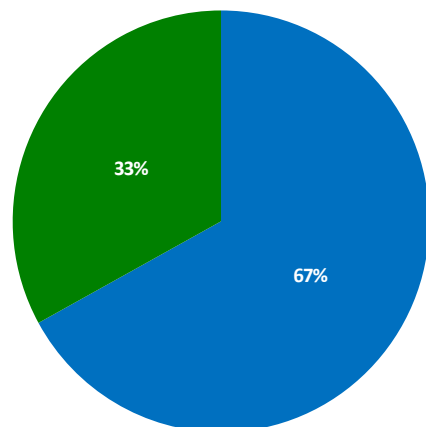

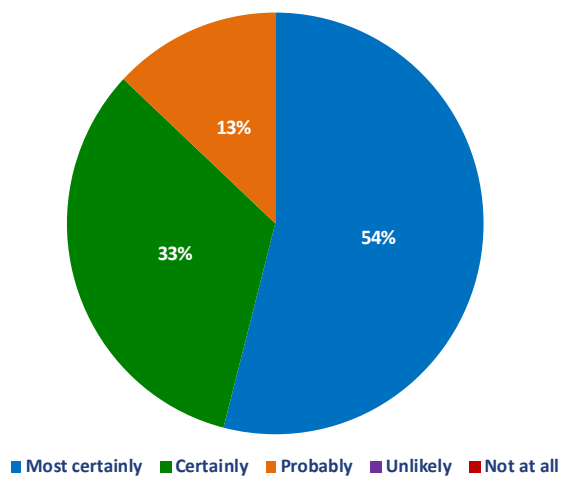
