# Orthopaedic Evaluation of X-Rays (OEOX) Course

Delivered by Consultants in Trauma and Orthopaedic Surgery, this one-day course aimed to provide junior doctors and allied healthcare professionals who are involved in the care of trauma patients presenting with fractures with the necessary knowledge to evaluate trauma radiographs and to minimise missed diagnoses.

The course discussed commonly missed symptoms and signs, as well as offering strategies for the interpretation of different radiographs. The day consisted of case-based discussions in the form of interactive lectures and small-group teaching.

This course was also suitable for clinical year medical students who are starting as Foundation Year Doctors in August 2022.
