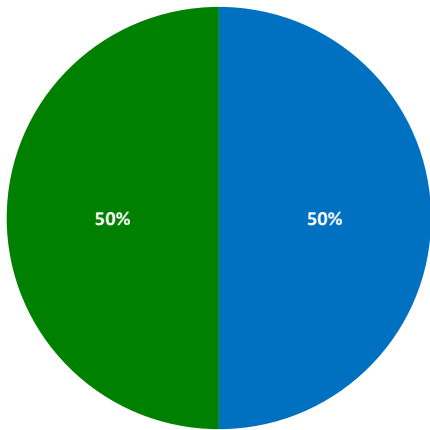

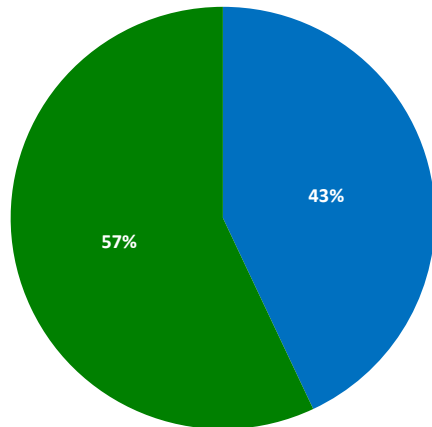

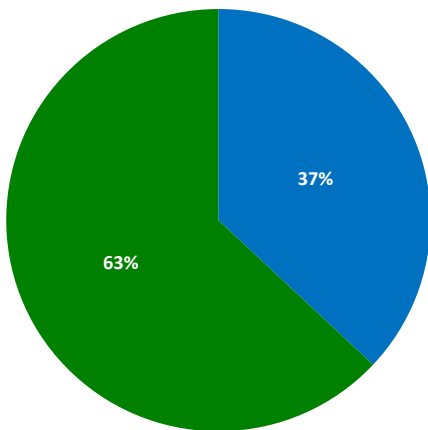

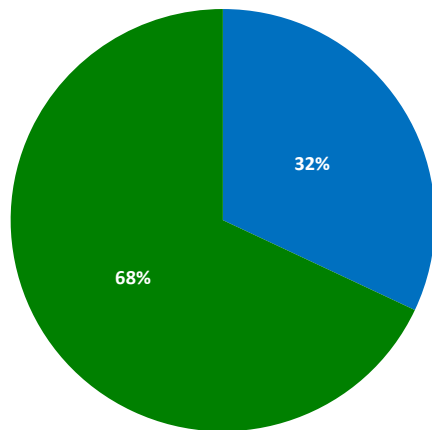

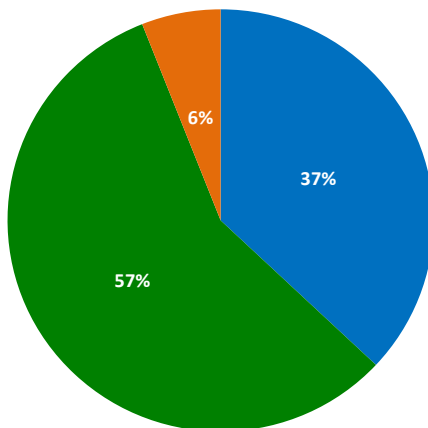

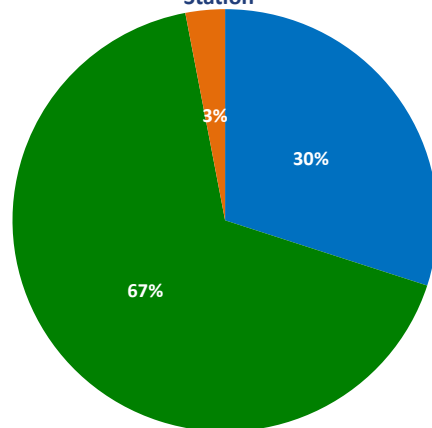

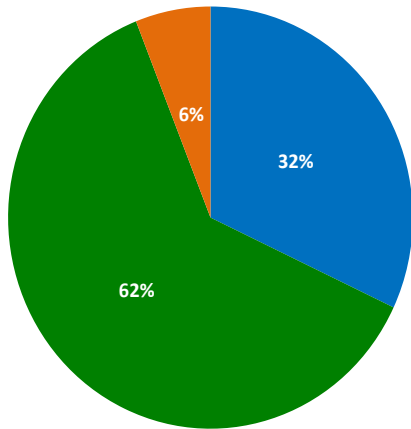
Mock Interview (2): Management Scenario Station

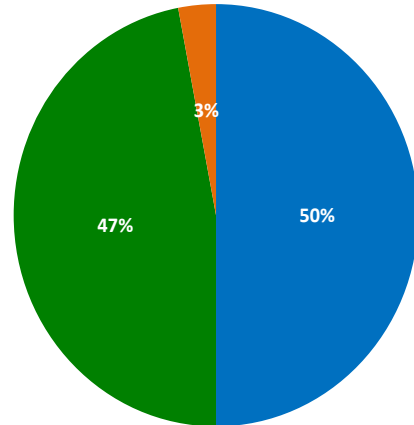

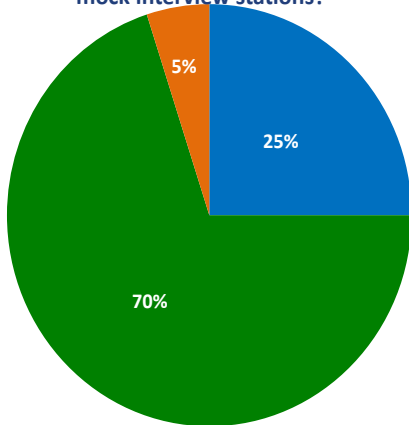

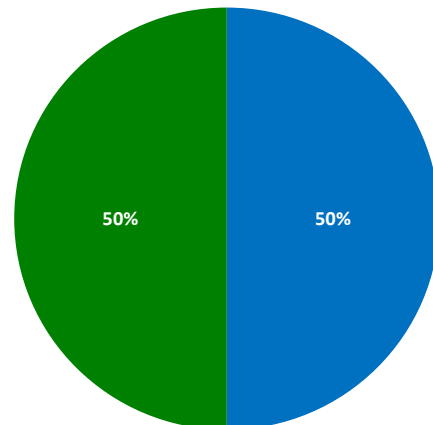

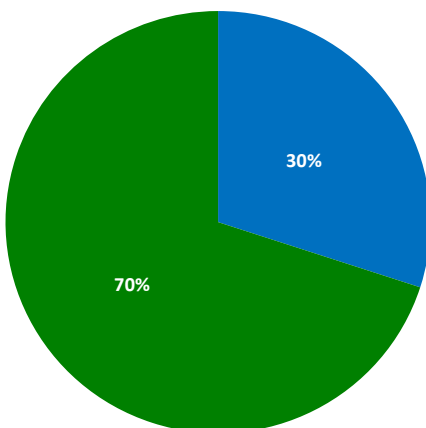

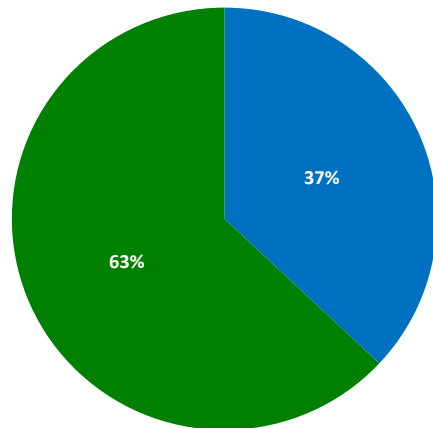
