The afternoon session enabled delegates to participate in small group workshops, including hip arthroplasty, knee arthroplasty and spinal fracture fixation. These were be led by senior Orthopaedic colleagues, allowing delegates to gain a better understanding of the technical demands of the specialty.







How would you rate the general academic standard of the speakers?




