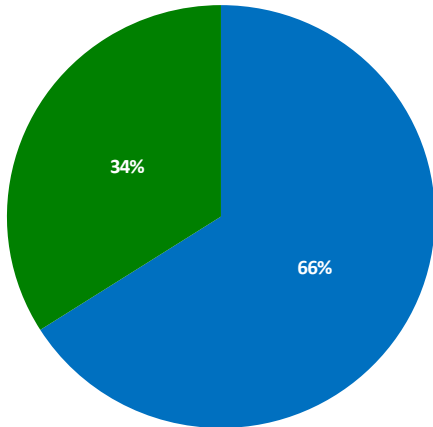

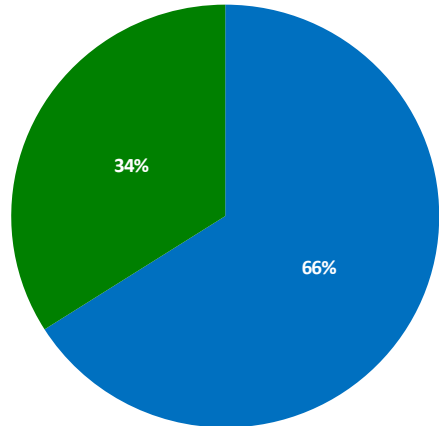

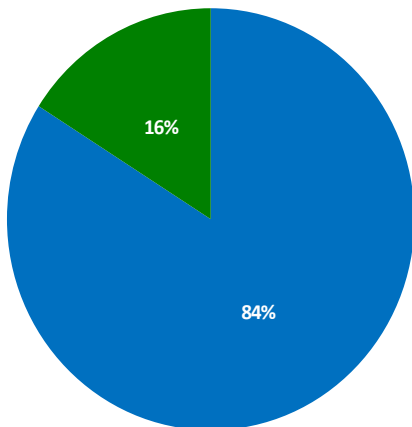

How would you rate the general academic standard of the tutors?



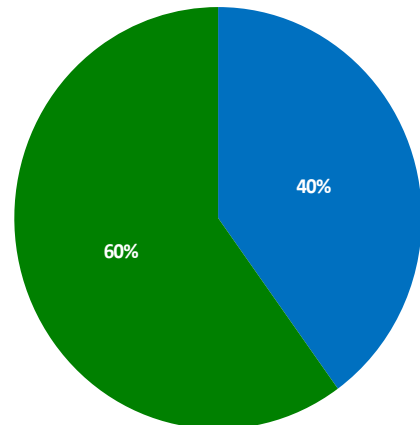

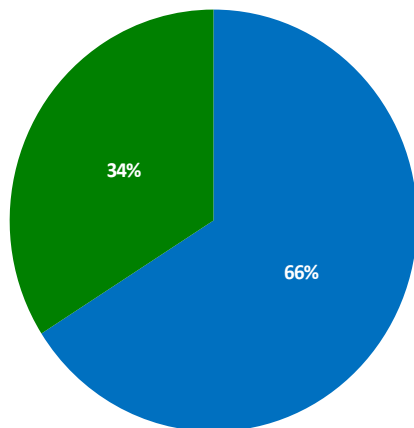

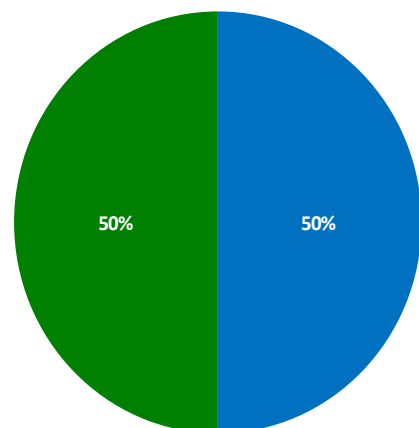

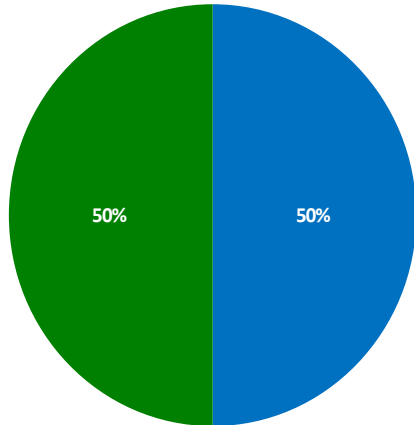

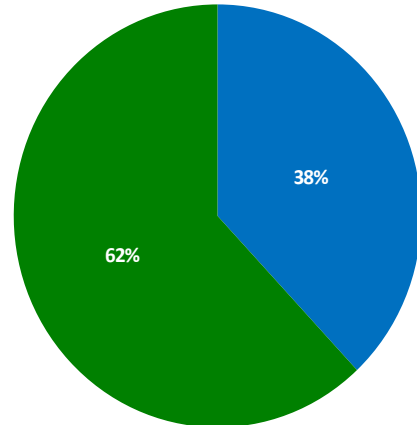

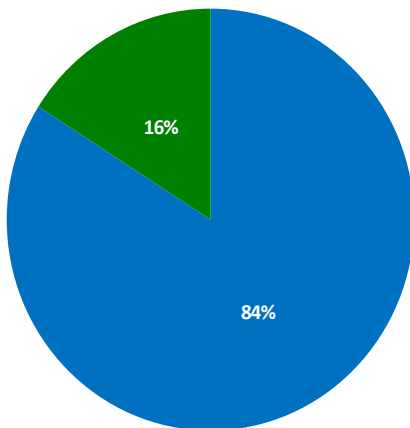

Workshop - Critical Appraisal & AFP



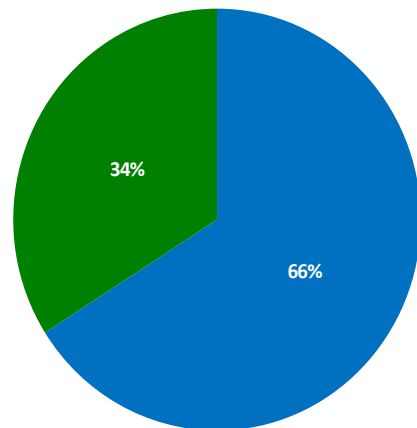

Workshop - CABG



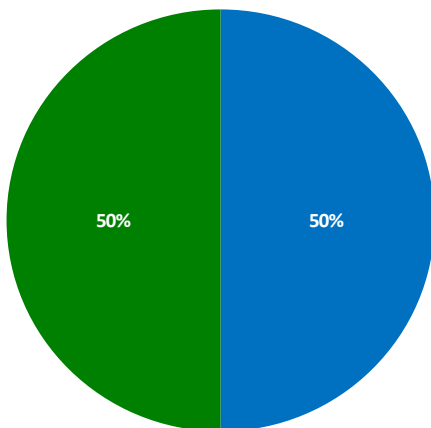

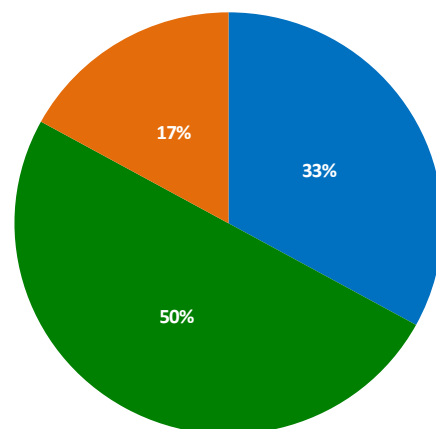
