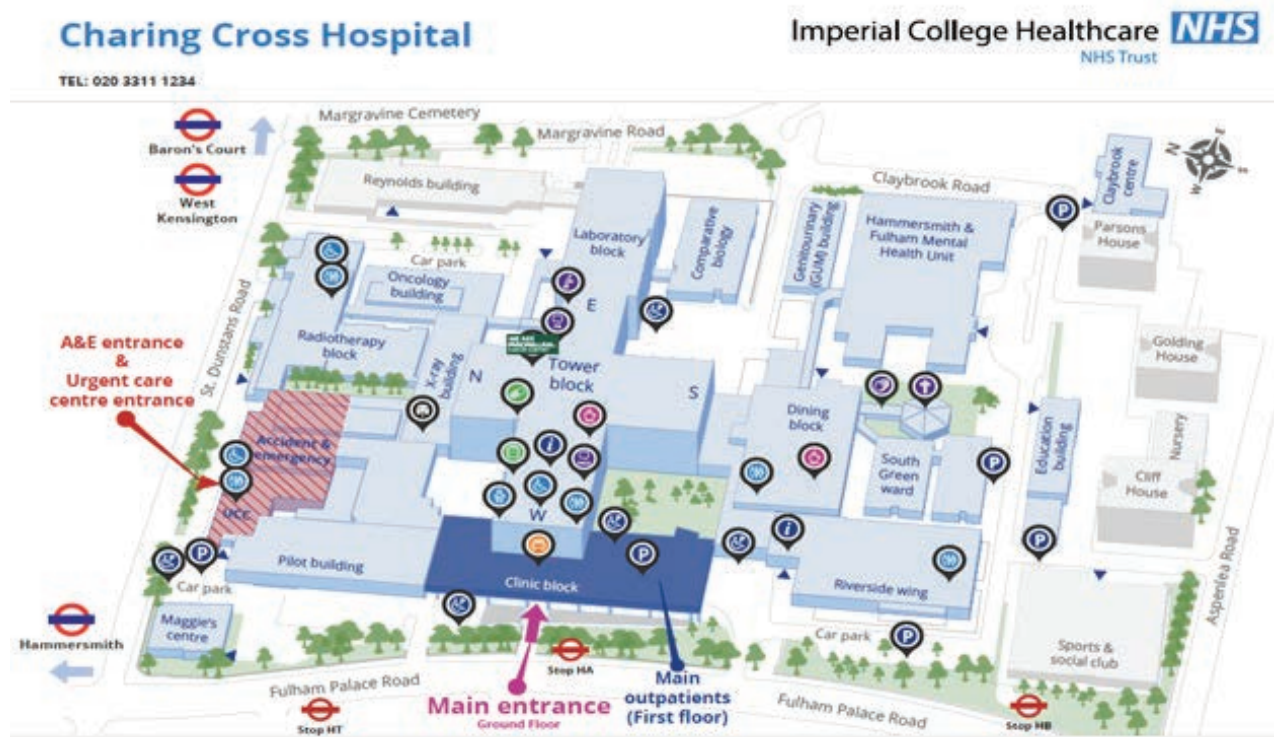

Tube:

The nearest tube stations are Barons Court (Piccadilly and District lines) and Hammersmith (Piccadilly, District, and Hammersmith & City lines).

Bus:

Bus routes that run close to the campus include routes 190 to West Brompton, 211 to Waterloo, 220 to Wandsworth and 295 to Clapham Junction. All buses will stop at either Stop HT or HA. The venue is a 5-minute walk from here.

III. PROGRAMME AND CONTENTS

There is always the possibility of a lecture over-running and some flexibility may thus be necessary within the programme. Due to the wide range of topics that will be covered during the course, we will adhere to a strict time-schedule. We will endeavour to observe the session times (i.e., morning and afternoon) and hence all breaks, and start and finish times, will be followed as per the programme.

Brief Description:

The day will start with a theory-based assessment (formative exam) of basic clinical anatomy. There will be 30 questions in PPT format. This score will not be used in the final evaluation. The teaching session will be structured as a combination of lectures, interactive discussions, and surface anatomy demonstration. Volunteers will be used for surface anatomy demonstration. The day will end with a formal assessment which will be carried out using PPT based spotters and a viva. The clinical/surgical anatomy teaching will be at the level required for MRCS Part A or MRCEM Part A, and will be useful if you intend to sit one of the above exams.

If you are planning to sit the MRCS Part A exam in the near future, you may wish to attend the Structured Revision for MRCS A Course which will take place on Friday 7th and Saturday 8th December 2018 at Imperial College.
