



A Theoretical and Practical Course on Minor Oral Surgical Procedures

This course used a hybrid learning approach to discuss core principles of minor oral surgical procedures, as well as to provide the delegate with ample opportunity to practise extraction techniques, flap elevation, various suturing techniques, bone removal using surgical motors, and the advancement of a flap for oroantral communication.

There were two evening sessions (1800-2000 hours), which took place via Zoom and discussed the key theoretical concepts that underpin important minor oral surgical procedures. There was also an attendance day during which delegates practised those procedures on animal tissue.

Delegates were required to attend all three sessions to receive a Certificate of Completion.
