Course Format/Content:

The course will follow the same format as the hugely popular course run by Dr Sally Scott in the United Kingdom for the last 28 years. This course is being organised by Dr Ailbhe Tarrant in conjunction with the Irish National Clinical Programme for Paediatrics and Neonatology. The course aims to provide the participants with a thorough understanding of the role of Ultrasound in the diagnosis and management of Developmental Dysyplasia of the Hip (previously known as Congenital Dislocation of the Hip).

The course will cover the theoretical knowledge and practical skills necessary to perform and interpret infant hip ultrasound examinations, and the management based on ultrasound findings. Aspects such as the choice of equipment and setting up an ultrasound service will also be covered.
